

Editorial



Every year on November 7, India observes National Cancer Awareness Day to raise awareness about cancer prevention, early detection and treatment. The Indian Union Health Ministry first introduced this in 2014. This day highlights the urgent need to address cancer as a public health concern. Cancer awareness is crucial, as it encourages people to learn about early symptoms, screening methods and the role of lifestyle choices play in prevention. According to WHO, timely diagnosis and treatment can prevent, detect and effectively manage one third of cancer cases globally.

Cancer is one of the leading causes of death worldwide, with around 10 million deaths each year. In India alone nearly 2.5 million people are living with cancer and about 14,61,427 (crude rate-100.4 per 1,00,000) cases reported in 2022. In India one in nine people are likely to develop cancer in his/her lifetime. Lung and breast cancers are the leading sites of cancer in males and females respectively.

National Cancer Awareness Day is celebrated to mark the anniversary of the renowned Nobel Prize Laureate, Madame Marie Curie. She was born in 1867 and she is celebrated for several of her ground breaking discoveries, which have contributed immensely to the ongoing battle against cancer. Her excellent research has helped in the developments in the field of nuclear energy and the use of radio therapy for cancer patients. It is a day of recognition for her significant role in advancing the field of oncology and improving the lives of countless individuals affected by this condition.

Types of Cancer -

Cancer occurs when cells in the body grow uncontrollably and spread to other parts of the body. The abnormal cells form tumors that disrupt normal body functions. There are five main categories of cancer.

- 1) <u>Carcinomas</u> The most common type which affects organs and glands such as breast cancer and prostate cancer.
- 2) <u>Sarcomas</u> These begin in connective tissues like muscles, bones and cartilage.
- 3)<u>Leukimias</u> Cancer of the blood which affects blood forming tissues such as the bone marrow.
- 4) $\underline{\text{Lymphomas}}$ Starts in the lymphatic system, impacting the immune system.

5) Melanomas - Cancer of the skin's pigment cells.

Signs and Symptoms -

Each type has specific symptoms and risk factors, but general signs of cancer include unexplained weight loss, fatigue, persistent pain, unusual lumps, unusual bleeding and changes in skin or moles.

Breast Cancer - It manifests as a lump in the breast on armpit, changes in the breast shape and unusual discharge.

Lung Cancer - Chronic cough, chest pain, shortness of breath and frequent infections.

Cervical Cancer - Unusual bleeding between periods, pain during intercourse and pelvic pain.

Prostate Cancer - Early detection is crucial for successful treatment.

Stomach Cancer - Risk factors include diet smoking and infection with Helicobacter pylori bacteria.

<u>Prevention of cancer</u> - While it is impossible to prevent all cancers, proactive choices can mitigate many types.

Quit Tobacco - Avoiding all forms of tobacco significantly decreases the risk of cancer particularly lung, mouth and throat cancers.

<u>Healthy Diet</u> - Eating a balanced diet rich in fruits, vegetables, whole grains and lean proteins can help lower cancer risk. Limiting red and processed meats, sugary drinks and highly processed food is also beneficial.

Regular Exercise - Aim for at least 150 minutes of moderate exercise each week to maintain a healthy weight and hormone balance both of which can influence cancer risk.

<u>Vaccination</u> - Vaccines like HPV and Hepatitis B can prevent certain infections linked to cancer.

<u>Limit Alcohol Consumption</u> - Reducing alcohol intake lowers the risk of liver, breast and colon cancers.

<u>Protection of Skin</u> - Using sunscreen and protective clothing can prevent skin cancer.

Routine Health Checkups - Regular screenings can catch cancer early,

improving treatment outcomes and survival rates. NGOs and social organisations can organize health checkup camps and cancer detection camps to pick up early cases of cancer and spread awareness regarding harmful effects of tobacco smoking, alcohol and unhealthy lifestyle.

Maintaining Healthy Body Weight can Reduce Cancer Risk

More than 50% of cancer cases are in advanced stages when detected which can greatly affect chances of survival. However early detection can help in full recovery. Spotting the cancer or precancerous changes early with the help of various screening methods will allow time for efforts that can help slow down or prevent cancer development.

My dear Brothers & Sisters

My divine love for all!

At the outset, I whole heartedly wish you all a **Shubh Deepawali**. Deepawali is the festival of Lights to illuminate not only the atmosphere but also to enlighten the souls to brighten our life, externally as well as internally.

Vasubaras, also known as Govatsa Dwadashi, marks the beginning of Diwali festival. We worship and feed cows and calves as a mark of reciprocation to the cows for their help in sustaining human life, as Go-mata.

Goddess Lakshmi, who had disappeared from the divine world, reappeared from Samudra Manthan, and she along with Lord Ganesha is worshipped on the Day of amavasya to get full grace of Maata Laxmi and Lord Ganesha, resulting in gaining Wealth from Lakshmiji and grace from two sons of Lord Ganesha, Shubh and Labh.

Next day we celebrate Bali Pratipada, in remembrance of Bali sticking to the promise given to Vaman avatar of Lord Vishnu and going to Patal Lok. On this day Bali visits Bhoo Lok and showers health and wealth to the people who worship him.

Next day signifies the eternal love between brother and sister. Sister offers 'aarti' to her brother and prays to God for longevity, well-being and prosperity of her beloved brother. Brother reciprocates this love by offering gifts to his beloved sister.




